
- The second largest religious building in Germany is the Cologne Cathedral.

# A history of Cologne



- Germanic settlement of Ubiów, around the fiftieth year transformed into a Roman colony. In 1288, the townspeople defeated Archbishop Worringen, after the archbishop's residence was moved in the 13th century to Bonn-a free city of Reich.
